



IT SERVICES including FREE WIFI

As a member of staff at The University of York, you are entitled to use IT Services and the Library.

Once you have registered for an IT User account, your University email address will automatically be added to our communication list. This is a great way of ensuring you are kept up to date on information and opportunities.

You can use your University User ID to access **FREE WIFI** via your smart phone/tablet/laptop. The free WIFI is not only available on site, but at various locations throughout York.

Once you have your username and password you can connect by typing the following link into your browser: www.york.ac.uk/it-services/services/wifi. Click on the "Network set up tool" link and follow the on screen instructions.

Once you have set your phone and/or device up on the University's **FREE WIFI** (eduroam), it should connect automatically when you are on campus or close to WIFI hotspots in York's city centre.
