Criminal justice related experience

The following organisations regularly recruit volunteers: Probation Service, Youth Offending Teams, Network 2, Victim Support and the Police (Special Constables). Please be aware that many of these organisations require a minimum of a years commitment, so best to look into these early during your time at York.
